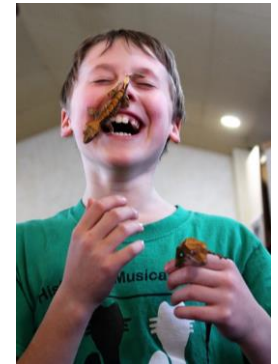
## What does HomeLink Yakima offer?

- Once-a-week in-person classes, with assignments to finish at home for students grades 1-12.
- Classes in session from September through May.
- Quarterly grades issued after each 8-week session.
- Quality Christian-based textbooks and resources.
- Trained instructors and experts in their fields guide each class.
- An accredited high school transcript and diploma is available for high school classes, easing transfer of credits. Those interested may register into the NARHS program which is fully accredited at the highest level by Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools.



### Three educational options to choose from.

1. **Individual classes** for middle school and high school meet on Tuesdays and Thursdays. Take 1 or more. (see schedule on reverse)
2. **Tuesday full programs** for middle school, 9<sup>th</sup> grade, and 10<sup>th</sup> grade offered for special pricing.
3. **Historical Theater-based all-inclusive program** for students in grades 1-8 on Wednesdays.



## Wednesday classes for MS and Elementary

**KATS Historical Musical Theater is an award-winning, highly motivating, hands-on learning program for students ages 6-ish(reading) to 13.**

- Includes full program – math, science, history and language arts, music, art, and theater
- Two levels offered – elementary (grades 1-5) and middle school (grades 6-8)

The focus for 2022-23 **“World Geography and Cultures”**.

Around the World in 80 Days by Jules Verne will serve as the base novel for both levels of classes.



- **Elementary:** Will develop theater skills through puppetry and stage productions. Sept-Dec: folk/fairy tales, Jan-March: “Small Things” (Mother Teresa), Mar-May: “The Crane’s Gratitude” (Japanese Folk Tale)

- **Middle School:** Core studies will correspond with the following theater productions:

Sept-Dec “German Christmas” performance in December

Jan-March Research and creation of “theme-based” paper, exhibit, webpage, performance, or documentary. In March, projects may be entered into the National History Day competition.

Mar-May Students will write and perform their own play inspired by the Jules Verne novel.
