HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS

Once a student turns 14, earning high school credit for high school level studies is possible. The cost for the transcript service adds an additional \$10 per month to the HomeLink tuition. Classes other than HomeLink classes can also be added to this transcript for an additional charge.
