ANCIENT HISTORY – Mrs. Katie Meinzinger

- Read "Story of the World" Ch. 31 Mauryan Empire of India
- Complete the Map Work for Ch 31 (Map attached, instructions below)
 - The Mauryans came after the Aryans, and attempted to unite India. The two major rivers were still very important to this new empire. Find the Ganges River and the Indus River and race them in <u>blue</u>. Make sure you also trace the Ganges Delta.
 - The Mauryan Empire covered the whole northern part of India and is shown on you map as the area within the dashed line. Shade this area lightly in red.
 - Circle the names of the **Arabian Sea**, the **Indian Ocean**, and the **Bay of Bengal** in <u>blue</u>.
- Answer the following <u>questions</u> for Chapter 31 (younger students discuss them with parents or siblings, older students write down your answers.)
 - 1. Are cities stronger if they are independent or if they are united together?
 - 2. What was the name of the Indian empire that united the cities of India together?
 - 3. Who was its most famous ruler?
 - 4. What is one (or more) of the kind things Asoka did?

READING/LITERATURE — Refer to the list of books given in class. Write down pages or chapters read.

If you're using another Language Arts, Reading or Literature curriculum, please write that down instead.

GRAMMAR/WRITING — Work on 1-2 pages a day. Write the number of pages completed.
