Get your pencil & notebook and draw a horizontal line in the middle of a page to divide it in half. (You only need to sketch on half the page.) 2.) Find an object in the room where you are that you would like to draw and place it on the table in front of you. Lightly outline the shape of the object you see in front of you to create a guide. 3.) Next, fill in the shapes: Focus on value (lightness & darkness) and fill in each shape you see with shading according to the value on the object. Remember that fishbowl optical illusion? Shading the value changes and proportion can help your drawing look 3D and give it depth. 4.) After you draw your subject in detail, sketch around it the background until it fills in the rest of space on your paper. </div>
