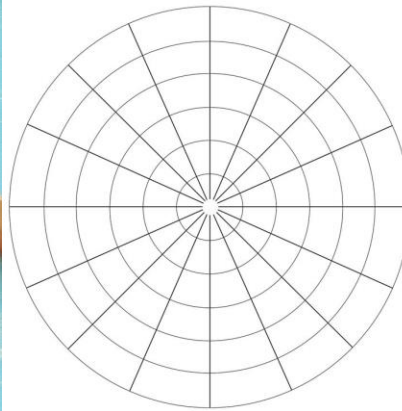

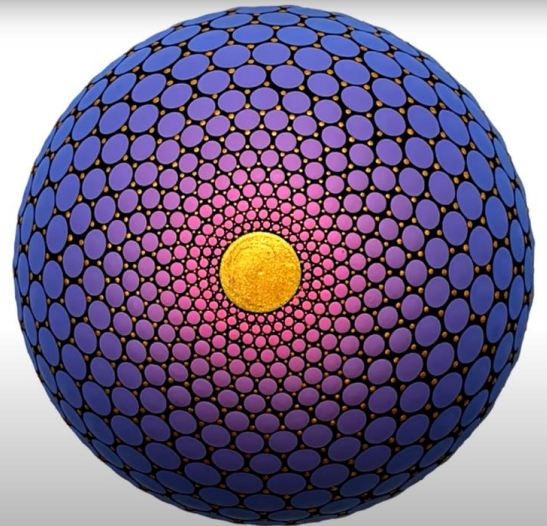

Mandala Rock Painting Guide:

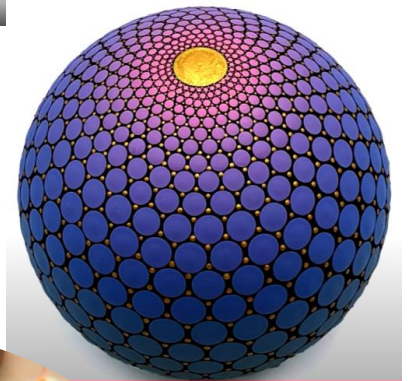
- 1.) Prepare your rock: Wash the rock thoroughly with water to remove any dirt and debris. Then pat off any excess water and let it air-dry completely before starting.
(This drying time gives you an excellent opportunity to decide on colors and collect supplies....)
- 2.) Collect your materials:
"All it takes is a look around your house and you are sure to find something that can work. Whether it is drill bits, toothpicks, or a thumbtack stuck to the bottom of a pencil eraser as long as they vary in size they are worth giving a try!" - <https://rockpainting101.com/dot-painting-beginners/>
- 3.) Choose your color scheme (3-4 colors) and design.
- 4.) Paint the background a solid color. A lot of people choose a dark background so the dots stand out.
- 5.) Once the basecoat is dry, use a pencil to draw a "mandala grid" below - <https://www.carlaschauer.com/how-to-make-a-mandala-grid/>

- 6.) Paint Consistency: for Dotting Something else to keep in mind is the paint consistency. You do not want to leave peaks when painting. If you paint is too thick simply add a drop of water to your paint. When you place a dot the paint should settle into a nice little dome of paint.
- 7.) Use the variety of objects around you to make different sized dots according to your design. (Big dot in the center, then circle with smaller dots, making sure there are equal and EVEN number of dots going around the first dot. The Next dot row gets bigger and they are placed *in-between* the previous row's dots.
- 8.) When completed, clean your brush, close your paint containers, and bring your rock painting to the next class and we will seal them with Mod Podge
