<p><u>Q2 Week 6</u> Jan 7:</p>	<p>Reverse Color Painting: using the calendar picture you chose in class and sketched out at home, paint the OPPOSITE color and value of what you see.</p>	<p><i>Can you use the understanding of complimentary colors (opposites) and value to accurately paint the NEGATIVE of the photo?</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Did you know that you can also see a negative image with you eyes? It's called a negative afterimage in the retina. To get an idea of what your painting might look like, under bright light, stare at your image for a long time without blinking until your photoreceptors in your eyes become overstimulated and fatigued, then look away at a blank page and see the colors and the light and dark reverse! • Have you noticed that photography film creates a NEGATIVE image? The negative image is the master image from which all positive prints are derived. • The retina and camera film are both light sensitive surfaces that convert light into an image. The spectrum of light reflected to your eye from an object is due to its molecular structure, and the different color wavelengths stimulate different cone cells in your retina.

(If possible, take a good photo of it with a phone.) – Take home the acrylic paint colors you need in the paint snap containers to work on your painting at home. (Return the snap containers.) You will also have next class to work on this project before you turn it in at the end of next class. – These will be hung up in the school house. – I will take a picture of each one and then create a NEGATIVE of it so we can see how well it converts to the original picture!!
