<b>Assignment due Tuesday MARCH 11:</b>	<p><b><i>HOMEWORK:</i></b></p> <p style="text-align: center;"><b><u>Your tapestry design:</u></b></p> <p>On the back side of this paper:</p> <p><b>1.) draw a large rectangle representing the shape of your final tapestry work.</b></p> <p>Choose the colors you want to work with and</p> <p><b>2.) mark those on a section of the page</b> to create and display your "color pallete."</p> <p><b>3.) Draw your desired design on your rectangle space</b>, keep it simple, maybe it's just sectioned into a few different squares, or you want to get more creative and try to do a simple landscape scene as the colors change. Color in each section.</p> <p><b>4.) Describe in 2-3 sentences the theme or idea</b> you have for the piece on the side of the drawing.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">You can take your frame &amp; web home with yarn I have provided, but <b>you must design your tapestry on the 8x11 paper keeping in mind what color yarns are available to you</b>, this is due NEXT class. Next class we will be working on that design and using the yarn provided in-class, and you will then be able to take the tapestry home to work on another week with supplies.</p>
