USE *one "alternative material" from home, (see below).</p> <p><i>*You must find and include this one item your piece: one household "alternative weaving material" you find at home.</i></p> <p><u>Examples:</u> natural twine & hemp rope, masking tape folded in half in long strips (can be painted), strips of black garbage bags, strips of cheap plastic table cloths, shoelaces, fabric scraps, etc</p> <p>If you need more ideas and directions, find a Youtube video online by searching "how to weave yarn on a tapestry web."</p>
